

ORDINANCE NO. 10-02

AN ORDINANCE TO DELETE SECTION 15-401 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, TENNESSEE, PERTAINING TO VEHICULAR PARKING ON PUBLIC STREETS, AND CREATING A NEW SECTION 15-401 PERTAINING TO THE SAME.

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen has determined that the public streets in the residential areas of Medina are not wide enough to safely accommodate normal traffic flows when motor vehicles are parked on them.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, TENNESSEE THAT:

Section 1. Section 15-401 of the Medina Municipal Code is hereby repealed in its entirety and shall be replaced with a new Section 15-401 reading as follows:

15-401. (a) No person shall park any motor vehicle on the municipal streets in the residentially-zoned areas of the City of Medina, as indicated in the city zoning map attached to this Ordinance.


(b) Exceptions. The provisions of Section 15-401(a) shall not apply to vehicles parked on municipal streets for the purpose of loading or unloading activities associated with moving or delivering household furniture, appliances, equipment, and similar objects, provided that such parking does not exceed twenty-four (24) hours.

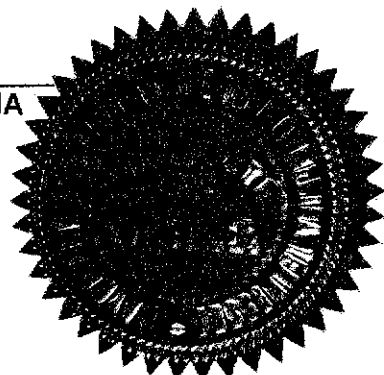
Section 2. The willful violation of this Ordinance shall result in a fine of \$20.00 for each offense.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective from and after its final passage, the public welfare requiring it.
